A team of students from Rangeview is advancing to the final round of the national Cyber Patriot competition, a cyber defense program sponsored by long-time Aurora Public Schools partner, the Northrop Grumman Corporation.

The Rangeview team competed with 190 teams to make a simulated computer environment a harder place for hackers to attack. The “Cyber Patriots” searched for security vulnerabilities placed in the system by the competition’s organizers. The Rangeview team solved more security problems than any other team in the region and is one of 12 that will compete at nationals.
