STUDENT FEES, FINES AND TUITION CHARGES

Except where specifically authorized by law, students in kindergarten–12th grade shall not be charged a fee as a condition of enrollment in school or as a condition of attendance in any class that is considered part of the academic portion of the district's educational program. State law allows the district to require students to pay textbook rental fees, fees for expendable materials, and other miscellaneous fees and deposits. It is the board's general policy to supply students attending grades K-12 with textbooks and instructional materials which are necessary for successful completion of courses of study approved as part of the district's curriculum free of charge. The board will generally not provide students with supplies necessary for school, such as writing instruments, paper and the like.

The board shall adopt all K-12 student fees. The fees shall remain in place until modified or removed by board resolution. These fees may be adjusted annually and fees for the books, materials, or supplies shall bear a relationship to the actual costs incurred by the district in providing such items.

Students may be required to pay the cost of materials for projects in classes when the student will retain the items produced. They also may be required to pay fees for specified classes in which no credit is given and for participation in or attendance at activities or programs not within the academic portion of the educational program.

The district may require each non-indigent child to make a reasonable loss or damage deposit to cover textbooks and nonacademic equipment, including musical instruments and the like. The deposits shall be refunded upon return of the textbooks or equipment in good condition, except for ordinary wear. If a deposit is not required and textbooks or equipment are lost, stolen, or not returned in good condition, students will be assessed up to the full cost for replacement or repair of lost or damaged school-owned books, materials, equipment or other property in accordance with law, board policy, and district procedures.

Moneys collected for assessed cost of replacement or repair will be credited to the accounts of the school from which the fee or charge is collected.

Fees and deposit requirements may be waived for those students who meet the district eligibility requirements and guidelines set for free and reduced-price meals. Teachers and principals shall

make every effort to be sure no student is denied the right to participate in field trips or other enrichment activities because of lack of funds.

Students may be assessed fines or other penalties in accordance with applicable law for lost, damaged or defaced books, materials or equipment.

Students from other school districts that have boundaries contiguous to the district may participate in interscholastic activities in the district if the school in which the student is enrolled does not sponsor the particular activity, and if the student meets the district's eligibility requirements for participation. Fees may be required.

1. A master list of all school fees **may** be submitted to the board of education no later than May 31, annually.

2. Elementary level fees:

Fees **may** be considered annually in May for expenses such as field trips, associated admission costs and other fees as approved by the board.

3. Secondary (middle school and high school) level fees:

Fees **may** be considered annually in May at a meeting of the board of education in the form of a published fee schedule.

Board approval shall not be required for the assessment of reasonable fees for field trips and admissions, and for voluntary participation or attendance at a school-sponsored co-curricular or extra-curricular activity or program.

Fees may be charged for athletics as established by the board of education.

The board encourages students to take advanced placement courses. Since students successful in advanced placement classes become eligible to gain college credit, the cost of textbooks that become the property of the students and the cost of qualifying tests shall be borne by the students.

In secondary physical education classes, students will be required to supply a gym suit that conforms to the district standards.

Student fees for courses at T.H. Pickens will vary based on the course. A complete listing of all T.H. Pickens student fees may be found in their bookkeeping office, their registration desk and their counseling office. These student fees will be reviewed and approved annually.
