## NONDISCRIMINATION ON THE BASIS OF DISABILITY

The Board directs the Superintendent to adopt grievance procedures set forth in AC-R that shall be utilized to provide for the prompt and fair resolution of student and employee complaints alleging any action prohibited by this policy or by the laws and regulations referred to in this policy.

Those who wish to file a formal grievance shall utilize the grievance procedures stated in regulation AC-R.

A statement of the Board's policy against discrimination on the basis of disability shall be included in the district's recruitment materials and in publications containing general information which it makes available to participants in its programs, applicants for positions in its programs and applicants for employment. This statement shall identify the person(s) (by title) designated by the Superintendent to coordinate compliance with the laws and regulations referred to in this policy.
