#### POLICY ADOPTION

APS Code: BGB

The Board of Education will maintain governance over legally mandated policies for the district. The Board of Education shall also adopt policies which give direction to the Superintendent of schools. Only officially passed motions of the Board, speaking authoritatively as a group, are binding on the Superintendent. The Board authorizes the Superintendent to adopt all other policies and regulations for the effective operation of the district.

Decisions, directions or instructions from individual board members, officers, committees or liaisons are not binding on the Superintendent or staff except in rare instances when the Board has specifically authorized such exercise of authority.

The Superintendent of schools shall be responsible for recommending to the Board of Education all policies, except those which may originate from members of the Board of Education.

In general, a policy shall be presented as an information item at a regular meeting and presented for discussion and vote at the next regular or special meeting. A proposed policy may be adopted on first reading if five members of the Board are present, and two-thirds majority "Aye" vote of the full Board votes in favor of adoption. If the above criteria is not met, the policy shall be resubmitted to the Board for adoption on second reading at the next regular or special meeting of the Board of Education.

All policies adopted by the Board shall be posted to the district's Web sites promptly. Technical or clerical amendments to policies or contracts may be made by the appropriate administrator provided the Board is notified of the amendment.
